- Ecosystem Compensation Guideline uptake & implementation
- Support: Carruthers Creek Watershed Plan, York Urban Forest Management Plans
- Provincial Policy Statement review & Special Advisor on Flooding

## Staffing, Funding, Service Demands

### **Ecology & Planning Policy**

- Many staff changes (competition from Metrolinx for TRCA staff)
- Hiring and training at all experience levels

#### **Source Protection**

 2020-2021 funding model subject to pending Regulations under Bill 108 – mandatory program

#### Research & Knowledge Management

- New requests for services (e.g. municipal urban forest study)
- Demonstrates importance of science to inform decisionmaking and confidence in quality of RKM work
- First priority: existing commitments and deliverables










