

Purpose

Objectives

- Ensure a collaborative and systematic approach to data collection, analysis, and synthesis
- Ensure timely translation of science and effective knowledge transfer for practical applications including:
 - Land use and infrastructure planning processes
 - Corporate programs and technical guidance documents
 - External initiatives including municipal strategies, plans, and official plan reviews, provincial and federal policy guidance documents

Priority Deliverables

- Finalize the TRCA Research Agenda and track TRCA research initiatives
- Direct the development of a research and science communication strategy
- Provide focused effort and collaboration towards watershed planning
- Guide the development of tools to support TRCA decision making, including informing and streamlining land use and infrastructure planning
- Maximize the utility of data collected through the land use planning processes by developing data collection and management procedures and standards
- Support TRCA's digital transformation in regards to data and information sharing
- In partnership with the grant office, support and coordinate submissions to grants for research initiatives
- Support the development of a proactive monitoring and data collection approach to inform regional growth areas
