# Parks and Culture – Priorities

## Telling the Story of the Toronto Region at Black Creek

- Diversifying the story to include stories of people who lived in the Toronto Region in the 1800s;
- Ensuring the site is increasingly accessible to all through addition of ramps, touch artifacts, and visual aids.



# Parks and Culture – Challenges

## Exploring Alternative Operation Models

- Focus on making adjustments to the operating dates, times and the fee structure to help minimize costs while maximizing levels of service;
- Enhance and find new partnerships to optimize revenue generation opportunities;
- Exploring (with Grant Centre) government funding programs to help address aging assets;
- Develop new/updated program offerings.
