## Riddle Me This?

Flex your brain muscles and see if you can solve the following riddles:

Question #1: Two bodies have I, though both joined in one. The more I stand still the faster I run.

Question#2: In a one-story blue house, there was a blue person, a blue cat, a blue fish, a blue computer, a blue chair, a blue table, a blue telephone, a blue shower.... Everything was blue! What colour were the stairs?

Question #3: I am seven letter word. I am very heavy. Take away two letters from me and you will get 8. Take away one and you will get 80.

Question #4: Five people were eating apples, A finished before B, but behind C. D finished before E, but behind B. What was the finishing order?

Question #5: The day before two days after the day before tomorrow is Saturday. What day is it today?

Question #6: Four people are crossing a bridge at night, so they all need a torch—but they just have one that only lasts 15 minutes. Alice can cross in one minute, Ben in two minutes, Cindy in five minutes and Don in eight minutes. No more than two people can cross at a time; and when two cross, they have to go at the slower person's pace. How do they get across in 15 minutes?

Question #7: There are three bags, each containing two marbles. Bag A contains two white marbles, Bag B contains two black marbles, and Bag C contains one white marble and one black marble. You pick a random bag and take out one marble, which is white. What is the probability that the remaining marble from the same bag is also white?
