
What is the TRCA Youth Council?

Goals:

- Inspire, empower and engage youth



TRCA Youth Council Program Framework








Who is the Youth Council?

- Network of youth 16 to 30
- Must live or attend school within TRCA's jurisdiction

Two ways to participate:


- General members are passive, intake is open year-round. Currently at 320+
- 10 Executive members volunteer for oneyear terms (2 years maximum).
 Application opens annually
- Youth Council Executive meets monthly and determines programs

Why Engage with the Youth Council?

- TRCA projects, programs, and initiatives can benefit from youth perspectives and involvement
- The TRCA Youth Council provides opportunities to:
 - Engage and strengthen our networks with youth
 - Cultivate future environmental professionals
 - Incorporate youth perspectives into TRCA work
 - Expand the impact of TRCA's work

Engaging Youth and Strengthening Networks

- Collaborating on events and initiatives
 - E.g., Patagonia and Toronto Zoo documentary screenings
 - Internally with Conservation Youth Corps, Community Learning Programs
- Inviting individual Youth Council speakers for presentations
- Alignment with other youth organizations



Cultivate Future Environmental Professionals

- Executive members gain leadership experience, organizational, event planning and public speaking skills through their terms.
- Executive Members:
 - Suggest, plan, and implement event ideas
 - Bring in their own expertise
 - Toronto Islands history tour
 - Upcoming workshop at the Conservation Youth Corps' climate action retreat
 - Have gained employment at TRCA and other environmental organizations





- Career-oriented opportunities for General Members increase connections to TRCA
 - Summer Challenge prize includes meeting a TRCA staff member
 - Careers webinars with Youth Council Executives and/or TRCA staff
 - Opportunity to experience TRCA roles
 - Job shadowing possibilities


Youth Perspectives and Involvement in TRCA Work



- Participation in Youth Council events
- Monthly newsletter promotes surveys, upcoming events, job and volunteer opportunities
- Youth Council presence at TRCA events
- Surveys and research projects:
 - Youth Council Executive invited to sit on Oak Ridges Trail external advisory committee → Trails survey
 - Research project on barriers to youth in conservation spaces
- Within TRCA:
 - Regional Watershed Alliance participation
 - How to incorporate youth perspectives further into TRCA work?

Expanding the reach of TRCA's work

- Youth Council members can be advocates for TRCA work to outside organizations
 - E.g., presentations at Ontario Science Centre and Brampton Environmental Alliance
 - Cultivating environmental champions
- Access to a ready-made forum for youth engagement and advocacy for TRCA work
 - Can be more targeted (Executive) or can have access to a broader youth network (General Membership)
